Jason Henderson called the January 2024 Athletic Affairs Committee meeting to order at 2:03pm.

**Personnel Updates**

- Greg Bamberger welcomed Ronald Leisie (RJ) as our new Director of Athletic Communications on January 8, 2024. Ronald is from Guilford College in Greensboro, NC, a native of the Pittsburgh area, and alum of Waynesburg College.
- Greg Bamberger announced that head football coach, Jason Woodman, moved on to the head football coaching position at Morehead University at the turn of the year. One of our full-time assistants is joining him. The search for a new head football coach is wrapping up.
- Greg Bamberger announced that head golf coach, Sarah Yost, has stepped away from the lead position with the program, but will still be involved in an Assistant Coach's role. Rick Johnson of Bridgeport, WV has agreed to take over the head coaching responsibilities.

**Winter Sports Updates**

- Greg Bamberger announced that Women's Basketball is first place in MEC (15-2, 9-1 MEC) and ranked as high as 9<sup>th</sup> in the country. They are looking forward to regional rankings. Greg Bamberger stated that the hope is to be in a position to participate and possibly host a regional tournament.
- Greg Bamberger announced that Men's Basketball is presently tied for 5<sup>th</sup> in MEC (13-4, 6-4 MEC). They had a slow start to the year, but playing much better at this point.
- Greg Bamberger announced that Wrestling is at a 10-12 dual meet record. He stated that they are still a young program, and it is just the second year under this coaching staff. Greg Bamberger stated the Wrestling Team is ready to compete in MEC championships this coming weekend. Their hope is to match or better their highest finish ever of 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
- Greg Bamberger announced that Men's and Women's Swimming season is going along well. They are celebrating senior day this coming weekend. Three seniors will be recognized. Swim Teams are preparing for championships in the middle of February.
