The Board of Governors will review and approve a new Campus Carry Policy for **Fairmont State** University.

The President will establish any necessary Administrative Procedures and implement the new Board Policy.

# The Campus Carry Committee (CCC)



CCC was established in Fall 2023 to reccomend how to comply with the "Campus Self Defense Act"



CCC includes 14 members: students, faculty & staff from across campus



CCC will make recommendations to University Leadership, who will seek additional input



CCC's charge is to ensure a comprehensive & ideologically neutral approach



The law goes into effect on July 1, 2024
