READING SPECIALIST, M.ED.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The 100% online M.Ed. Reading Specialist program provides an opportunity for currently licensed teachers to earn the credits required for the Reading Specialist Certification in an online format. The program offers the following two tracks for candidates:

1. The Master of Education Degree is a 30-credit hour online degree program that includes a Reading Specialist licensure endorsement.

2. The Reading Specialist Certification (licensure endorsement only) is a 24-credit hour online program for licensed teachers who currently hold a Masters degree and would like to add a Reading Specialist endorsement.

The Reading Specialist program prepares candidates to serve as Pre-K to Adult reading specialists who offer literacy leadership and work with other educators to evaluate students' reading abilities, plan assessments, and provide appropriate reading and writing instruction and support for struggling readers. Program graduates have the knowledge, skills, and dispositions to serve their schools and communities as resource persons and plan collaboratively and cooperatively with other professionals to offer programs for diverse populations of learners. Graduates of the Reading Specialist program are also prepared to provide leadership as they advocate for children and families, and provide professional development opportunities at local and state levels.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

Graduates of the Reading Specialist program are prepared for careers in teaching, coaching, coordinating instructional programs, diagnosing and treating literacy problems, as well as leading school reading programs, such as Title I. Reading Specialists/Literacy Coaches may also serve as a resource in reading and writing for educational support personnel, administrators, and teachers; provide professional development; build and implement reading programs, and serve as advocates for family literacy.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How are courses offered in the program?

Courses are offered in Spring, Summer, & Fall.

Q. Does it matter when I start taking courses?

No, students may begin the program at any time. Students begin taking courses once they are admitted into the program. For example, a student may start in the Fall semester and take READ 6300.

Q. How is the program delivered?

The program is offered completely online. Each course is based on the course requirements & by the course instructor. Courses are offered asynchronous (student may log on at any time). Students must have access to the internet with a computer that can download documents, video, & audio clips. Some courses may have additional requirements, those will be provided in the syllabus at the onset of the course.

Q. How long will it take to finish the program?

The program is designed to accommodate practicing educators. Each course is 3-credit hours. Students may attend full or part-time. A student attending full-time for the M.Ed. may complete the program in 3 semesters.

*Note: The Reading Specialist Praxis is required for the teacher licensure/certification process in many states.
