

Welcome to Housing at Fairmont State University! We have five different residential options for you to choose from. You will need to follow all steps within the application process and pay your \$200 deposit through this online portal. A receipt will be generated automatically at the time your payment is approved. Your application is not considered complete until we receive your application and deposit!



Cancellation Policy for New Students:

A deposit of two hundred (\$200) dollars is to accompany this application and lease to reserve a space in our residence halls. Both parent and student must sign the lease if the student is under age 18. If your plans to attend the institution for the Fall semester change, written notification of cancellation must be received by the Residence Life Office prior to May 31st. For the Spring semester, written notification of cancellation must be received by the Residence Life Office prior to November 30th. Please refer to items one (1) and two (2) in the Residence Hall Terms and Conditions for cancellation and release expectations. Failure to notify this office by the appropriate date will result in forfeiture of the deposit. No deposit refunds will be granted for cancellations received after the above dates. Deposits will not be refunded for any type of release. (Exception: Should the applicant be denied admittance to the institution, a full deposit refund will be made.)





Gender Inclusive Housing Options

Fairmont State University recognizes that same-sex room assignments are not ideal or appropriate for all students. Gender Inclusive Housing seeks to provide an environment that is welcoming to all gender identities and is not limited to the traditional gender binary (male and female). Gender Inclusive Housing allows for students signing up for these areas to be permitted to have roommates and suitemates regardless of gender identity.

Any student who is eligible to live on campus is eligible to apply and live in Gender Inclusive Housing. Students will not be required to reveal their reasons for opting to live in Gender Inclusive Housing, although romantic relationships within the same living space are not permitted.



Fairmont State University 2019-2020 Academic Year Terms and Conditions Please read the terms and conditions carefully and completely. This is a

legally binding agreement between you and The Office of Housing and Residence Life.

1. Terms and Conditions

Resident will be defined as the student signing (or the student being signed for by a parent/legal guardian) this contract. Resident agrees to pay Fairmont State University the cost of room rent for the 2019-2020 (cademic year at the beginning of each academic semester. A deposit of \$200.00 is required to accompany this contract to reserve a space in the residence halls. This contract is for one academic year (August 16, 2019 – May 9, 2020). Resident understands Fairmont State University and Pierpont Community and Technical College have a requirement that all students must live on campus for four consecutive semesters. Resident must live on campus for four consecutive semesters. Resident must live on campus for four consecutive semesters unless Resident meets an exemption to the requirement (see below). Failure to pay all fees due will result in Resident being placed on financial hold, during which time transcripts or semester grades will not be released, and Resident will be prevented from registering for subsequent compared. 


