

NURSING – ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAM APPLICATION

School of Nursing and Allied Health Administration

The Associate Degree Nursing program is a two-year limited enrollment program. Graduates of the program are eligible to take the licensing examination to be a Registered Nurse after approval by the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Nurses.

The applicant must submit evidence of all post-secondary education (attempted or completed), as well as official high school, college and LPN transcripts to Enrollment Services. ACT, SAT, or COMPASS scores are evaluated in the admissions process, along with the nursing pre-test (TEAS). Admission to the Nursing Program will be contingent upon your score on the Score Sheet for Selection, the results of a criminal background investigation and your health status.

A non-refundable application fee of \$20 must be submitted with the application. (Checks should be made payable to Fairmont State University.) The application deadline, as well as all required documentation, must be received by December 1st.

- (1) The minimum grade point average for admission is 2.0. Do you meet this requirement? _____
- (2) Does the Enrollment Services Office of Fairmont State University have a copy of your high school, LPN and/or college transcript? _____
- (3) Chemistry, Biology and Algebra are required before admission and must be completed by the application deadline. These can be high school or college level courses. High school courses require 2 semesters or 1 credit. College courses can be one semester. Have you taken and received a passing grade for chemistry, biology and algebra either in high school or college? _____
- (4) You must have a minimum ACT Math score of 19, a minimum SAT score of 460, an equivalent COMPASS score, or have successfully completed MATH 0095 or MATH 1107. Have you met this requirement? _____
- (5) You must have a minimum ACT English score of 18, a minimum SAT score of 450, an equivalent COMPASS score, or have successfully completed ENGL 0097 or ENGL 1104. Have you met this requirement? _____
- (6) Does the Enrollment Services Office of Fairmont State University have a record of your ACT, SAT, COMPASS test scores and/or college transcript(s) for Math 0095, English 0097 or English 1104? _____
- (7) You must attain a score of at least 50 on the Math and English components, a score of at least 60 on the reading component, and a score of at least 63 on the science component of the required nursing entrance examination, the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). Have you met this requirement? _____

** TEAS test can be taken only 2 times in a calendar year.
