Masters Degree in Leadership Studies Offered

Certified public school teachers interested in becoming principals can receive the training they need through FSU's new Masters of Education Degree in Leadership Studies. Working in collaboration with Marshall University, FSU would like to recruit students for the new program of study, which will begin with the fall 2005 semester.

The entirely web-based curriculum featuring 18 hours of leadership studies courses and 18 hours of general education courses will be administered on the Fairmont State campus. Upon completion of the program, graduates will be qualified for certification as pre-K through adult school principals in West Virginia, Kentucky and Ohio.

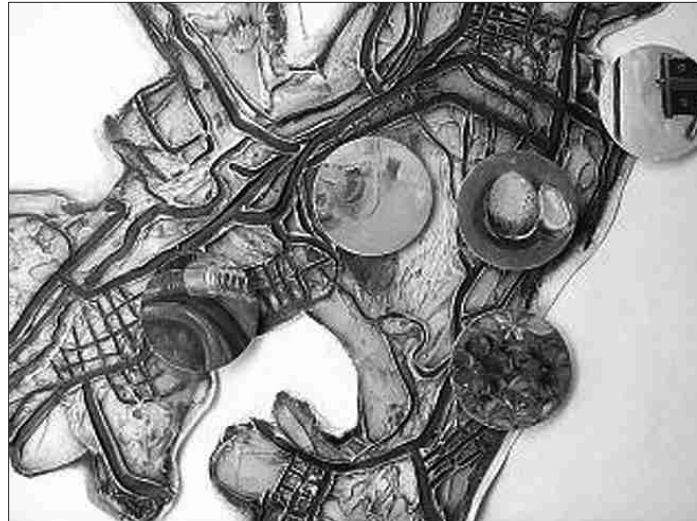
