1	Utilize normal students that already go here. Don't try to push new students to buddy up with freshman counselors who have to act nice to them for the money but are (in general) unhelpful and rude. Also inform freshmen about all out-of-class opportunities they have, especially clubs and organizations that aren't just Student Government or one of the bigger ones, as well as groups such as band that they can get credit for.
