EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

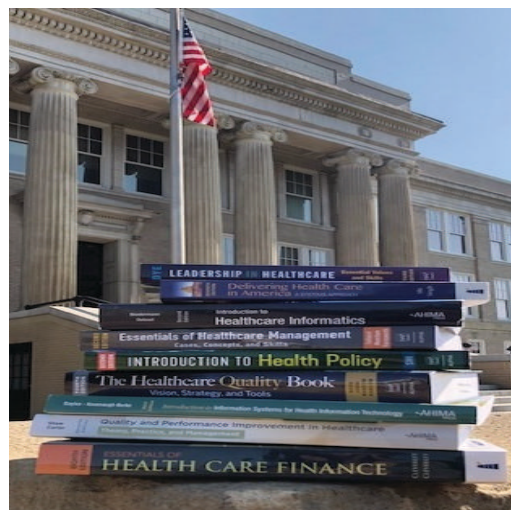
As the backbone of healthcare systems, healthcare administrators take on the duties of overseeing vast expanses of a care delivery system that includes strategy, stewardship, building teams, and leading an effective workforce. As the structure and financing of the healthcare industry changes, healthcare administrators must be able to adapt to new environments. A projected employment growth of 17%, higher than average for all occupations, is expected in the industry over the next decade. Graduates of a B.S. in Healthcare Management could expect to obtain entry-level administrative employment such as planning, directing, or coordinating medical and health services in a variety of health care organizations, up to and including, hospitals, clinics, skilled care facilities, home based services, public health agencies, or similar organizations.

Students also have the option to pursue a minor in Healthcare Management while majoring in any other bachelor's degree program at Fairmont State. A minor requires 21 credit hours (see page two for required classes).
