The 18-credit Nutrition Science Minor broadens the student's knowledge of the biological sciences, with a particular emphasis on the interdisciplinary nature of nutrition. The focus is to prepare students who intend to pursue careers in the food, health, and fitness industries, or those planning to enter health and exercise science, nursing, physical or occupational therapy, nutrition research, and nutrition communication. In addition, a minor in Nutrition Science could assist in providing a strong knowledge base for students planning to attend graduate or medical school.
