## **RESEARCH PROJECTS**

- 2017 Undergraduate Research: Artist as Entrepreneur, Corporate Partnership.  
Working with the development firm Action Pact to support artwork to fill healthy living communities in the mid-west. Student and FHSU alumni artwork has been commissioned and purchased amounting to \$21,500 for the Spring 2017 semester. Action Pact will continue this partnership with an annual purchase award, awarded during the student exhibition every spring at the Moss-Thorns Gallery of Art.
- 2016 Undergraduate Research: Public Art, "The Journey" Mural. Phase I of the Journey located in the Memorial Union of the FHSU Campus. Students assisted in the design and

development of this three-panel mural. Beginning with a trip to the Nelson-Atkins Museum in Kansas City to study the mural of regionalist Thomas Hart Benton in Fall 2015. Eight undergraduate students, two graduate students, and one visiting scholar from China assisted with the design, construction, and initial painting process. Processes instructed included best practices for purchasing, sketch to canvas transfer, budgeting, large scale paint mixing, and safety practices with working on large scale public art pieces.

2016 Undergraduate Research: Artist as Entrepreneur, Public Art, Connections 210 linear foot Mural Project. The connections mural at Early Childhood Connections, Hays, KS is a student designed, funded, and executed the public mural. The project incorporates five FHSU Department of Art and Design students from three major disciplines. The students and I fully fundraised this project. Fundraising efforts, design, planning, and execution of the project were skills taught to the students over the summer of 2016. Fundraising for the project was \$5,300 for student compensation. Supplies were donated separately amounting to \$1,400. Partnering with local business made fundraising possible.

2015- Undergraduate Research: Artist as Entrepreneur, Publishing Partnership Through Illustration. I lead undergraduate students Karissa Gonzalez-Othon and Emily Hendricks in illustration of publishing projects "Bug and Boo" and "Finding Your Hero" in cooperation with Authors Kyle D. Carlin, and Dr. Jamie Schwandt in co-operation and partnership with Publishing Company Kastle Books.

Undergraduate Research: Artist as Entrepreneur, Art on Loan Project. Partnering with local Hays businesses, and in collaboration with the Creative Art Society, the Art on Loan Project raises \$2,600 annually by providing a revolving selection of artwork rented out monthly. Students are responsible for installing and reinstalling work, as well as the invoicing and collection of payment. Accounting takes place with the assistance of the student organization The Creative Art Society and funds generated assist students with trips, visiting artists and events. Students are responsible for working as a group to determine funds distribution.
