

AVIATION FEES & INFORMATION

The Professional Flight Program at Fairmont State University is a unique degree program with an experience unlike any other academic endeavor at Fairmont State. Students interested in this degree program will need to be aware of the significant time and financial investments listed below that make this program rigorous and unique.

- The Professional Pilot Option is a selective program. Students are required to meet additional admissions requirements and academic standards to be considered for this program. We suggest students have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA from high school to be competitive.
- Students should expect to remain at Fairmont State University during the summer semesters to complete the necessary flight training. A student may be required to remain on campus during Christmas and/or Spring Break to remain current in their flight training.
- Students are required to schedule flight training 3-4 times per week, every week at our hangar.
- Our hangar is located in Bridgeport, WV, an easy 20 minute drive from Fairmont State University's Main Campus. For this reason, we highly recommend students have their own, reliable transportation.
- This program also involves a significant financial investment that is added in addition to Fairmont State University's regular tuition and fees & room and board. Students should expect to secure and explore funding options through the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships.
