Dear Residence Hall students:

Move-In is just around the corner! If you haven't already registered for move-in, make sure you do so by the end of the day today. If you do not register by that date, you will be assigned a move-in time. Please [check out our webpage for more information about Move-In!](#)

Remember, upon arrival to campus, you and all persons traveling with you must undergo a health screening for COVID-19 at the Wellness Tent. This includes taking your temperature and answering a series of questions. For your convenience, the questions are attached to this email for you to review prior to traveling to campus. You are not permitted to fill out this form until you arrive. Don't worry, our team will complete this form for you; there is no need to print this out.

The Wellness Tent will be located in the **gravel parking lot across from campus on Locust Ave**. All students must first report to the Wellness Tent for a screening. After passing the health screening, you will be permitted to go to your assigned residence hall to check-in, receive the keys to your new home, and unload your belongings.

If a student or any person traveling with the student does not pass the health screening, the student will not be permitted to drop off or enter the residence halls. Students and their guests who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to leave the campus and self-isolate off campus for 14 days prior to returning. Upon returning to campus, the student would need to undergo another health screening before entering the residence halls. A guest will not be permitted to assist with the move-in process.

Please make sure you arrive on campus close to the beginning of your registered move-in time. You will not be permitted to enter the residence halls before this time, and we don't want you to have to wait around campus. As always, safety is our first priority in this process.

Don't forget to bring your mask and gloves to campus for move-in! Masks are to be worn at all times when within the residence halls and outside of your assigned residence hall room. Your mask must cover your nose and mouth at all times.
