## UPPER DIVISION COURSES – 39 Hours (minimum)

These courses may be selected from courses numbered **3300–4400** in any academic area. However, the student must meet all prerequisites or consent of instructor that may be required.

## REMAINING COURSES OR CREDITS – 45 Hours (minimum)

Students may earn the remaining credits by completing additional courses, presenting CLEP or military credits, taking departmental exams, or developing portfolio work based on experiential learning. Portfolio work must be tied to a specific course, currently taught at Fairmont State or participating WV public institutions. Standard awards for credit are possible upon review of certifications and licenses that the state RBA program has established as credit bearing. All requests for credit based on learning other than college course work must be applicable to meeting degree requirements and approved by the RBA Degree Program Coordinator.

## RESIDENCY – 24 Hours

Students must complete a residency requirement of 24 hours of course work taken at one or more institutions in the WV Public Higher Education System. At least 12 hours of course work must be completed at Fairmont State.

## TOTAL HOURS – 120 (minimum)

RBA students must complete a minimum of 120 hours of college credit with overall and institutional GPAs of at least 2.00 to be eligible for graduation.
