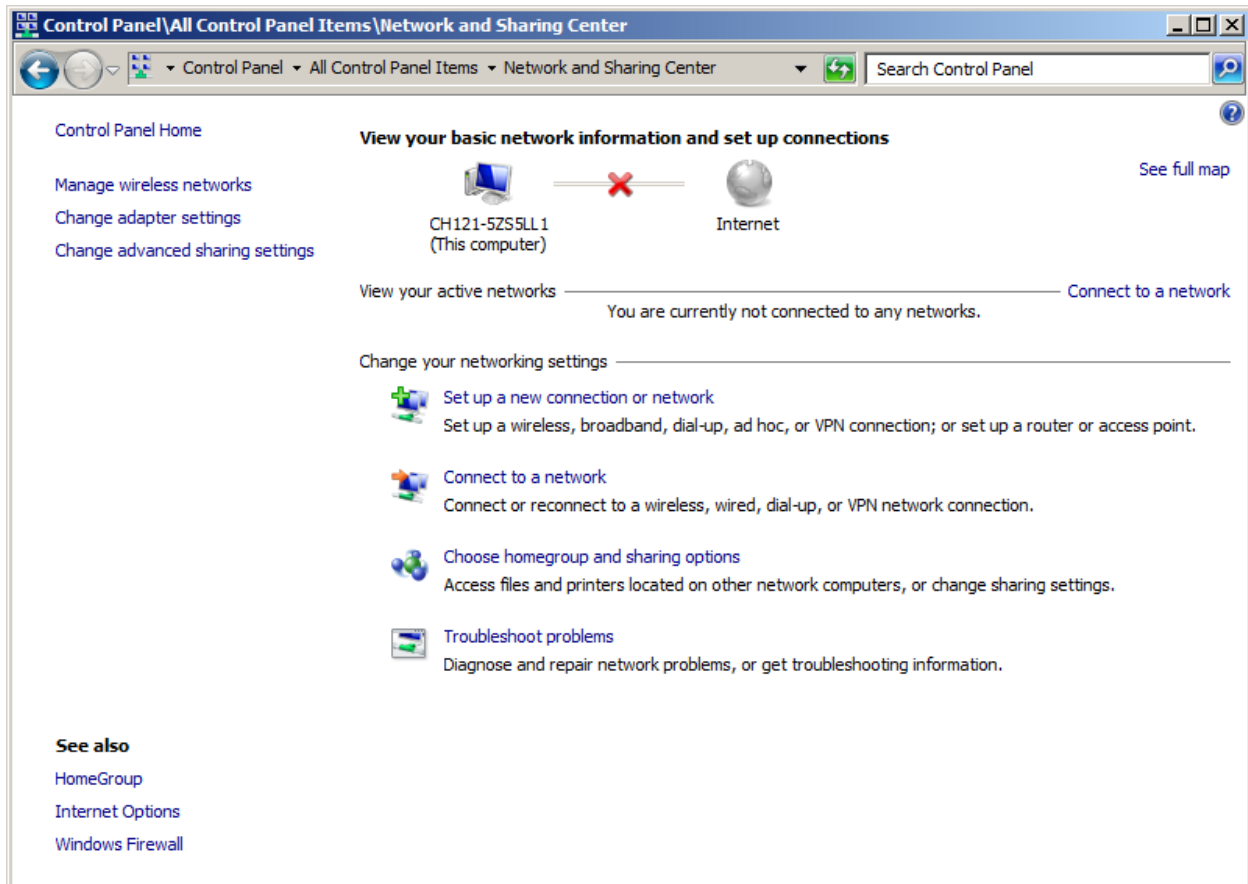


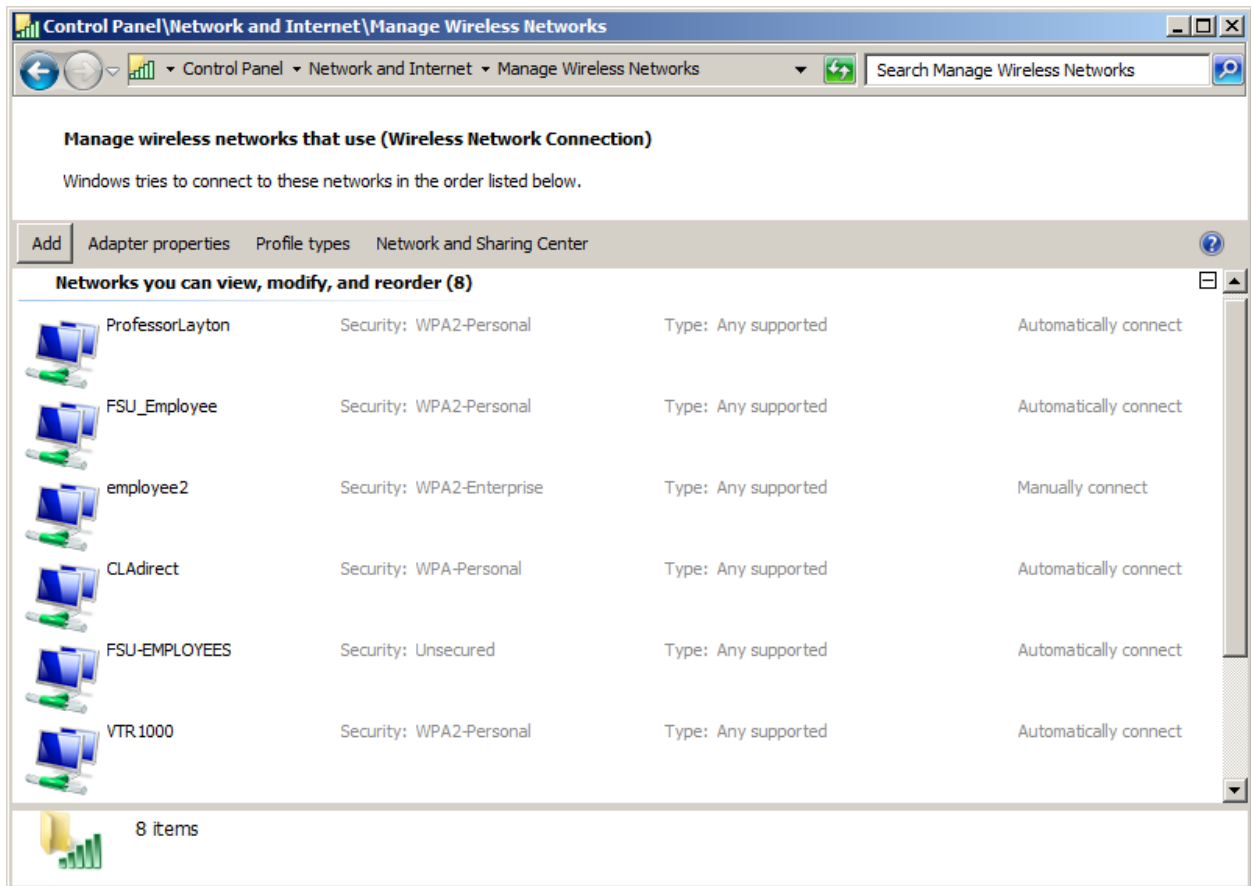
Windows 7 Wireless Configuration

Go to Start → Control Panel → Network and Sharing Center

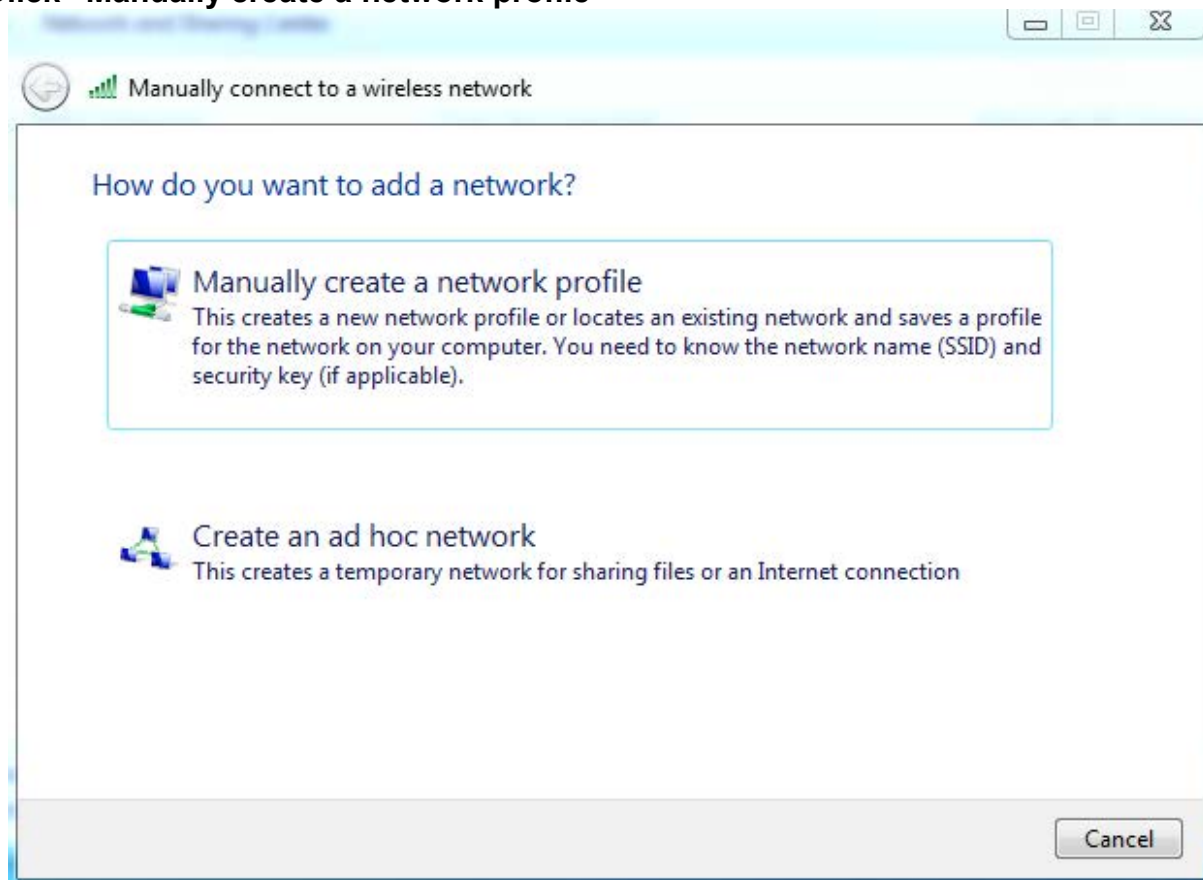
Click “Manage wireless networks” on the left



Click "Add"



Click “Manually create a network profile”



Enter the information exactly as pictured below and click next

Manually connect to a wireless network

Enter information for the wireless network you want to add

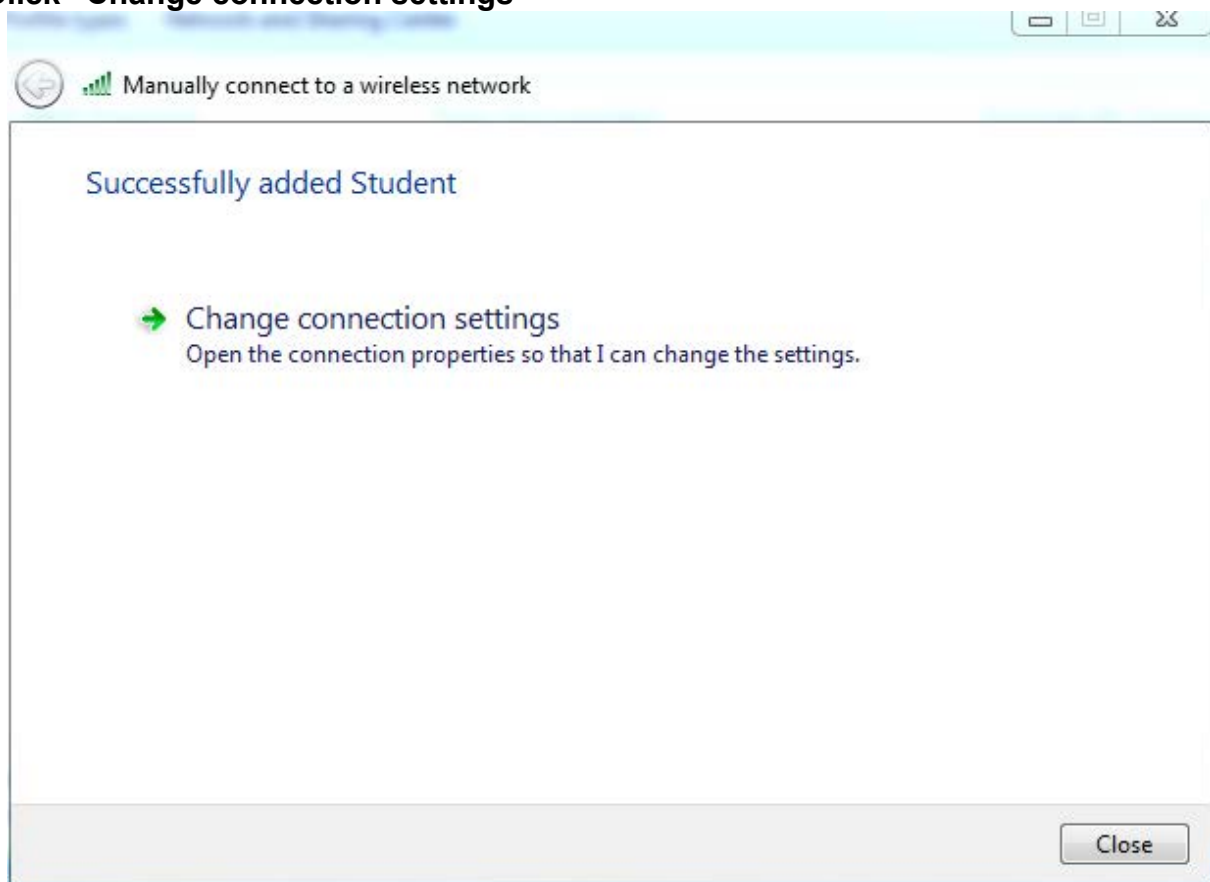

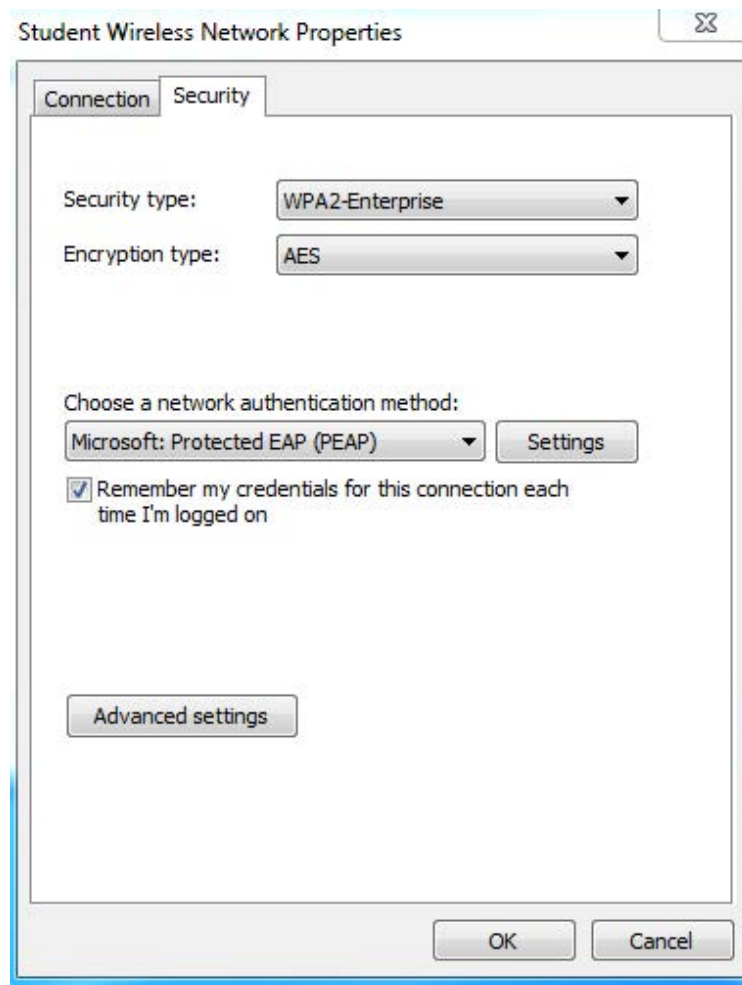

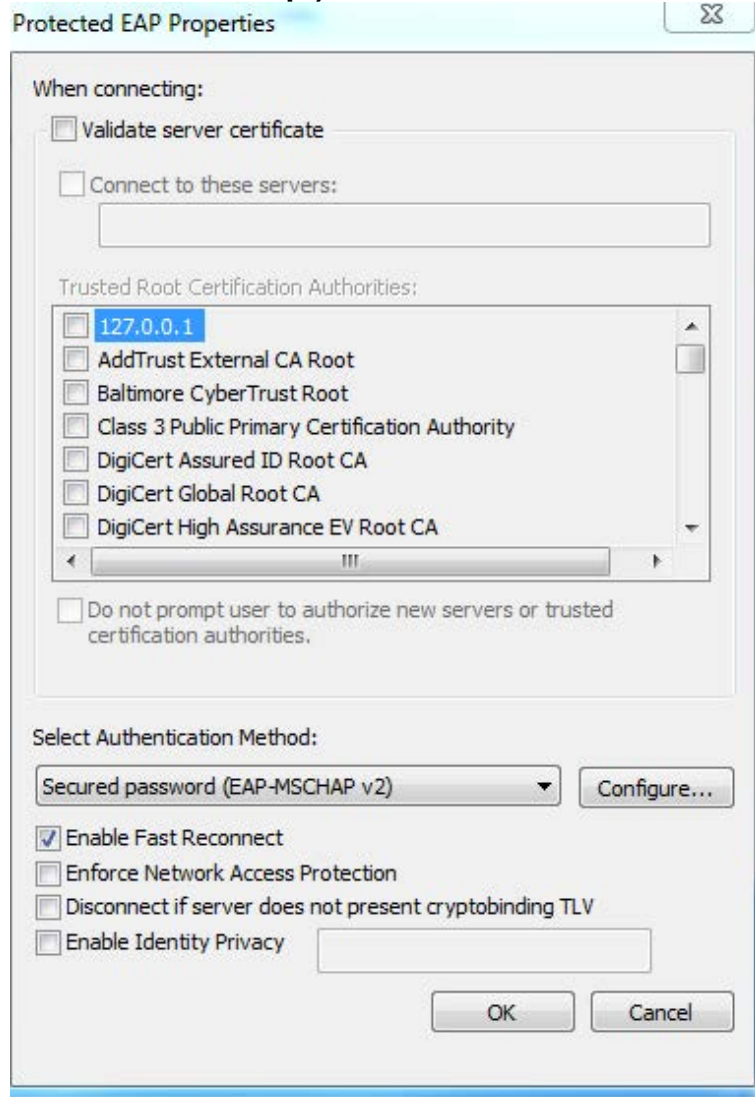
Click "Change connection settings"

button

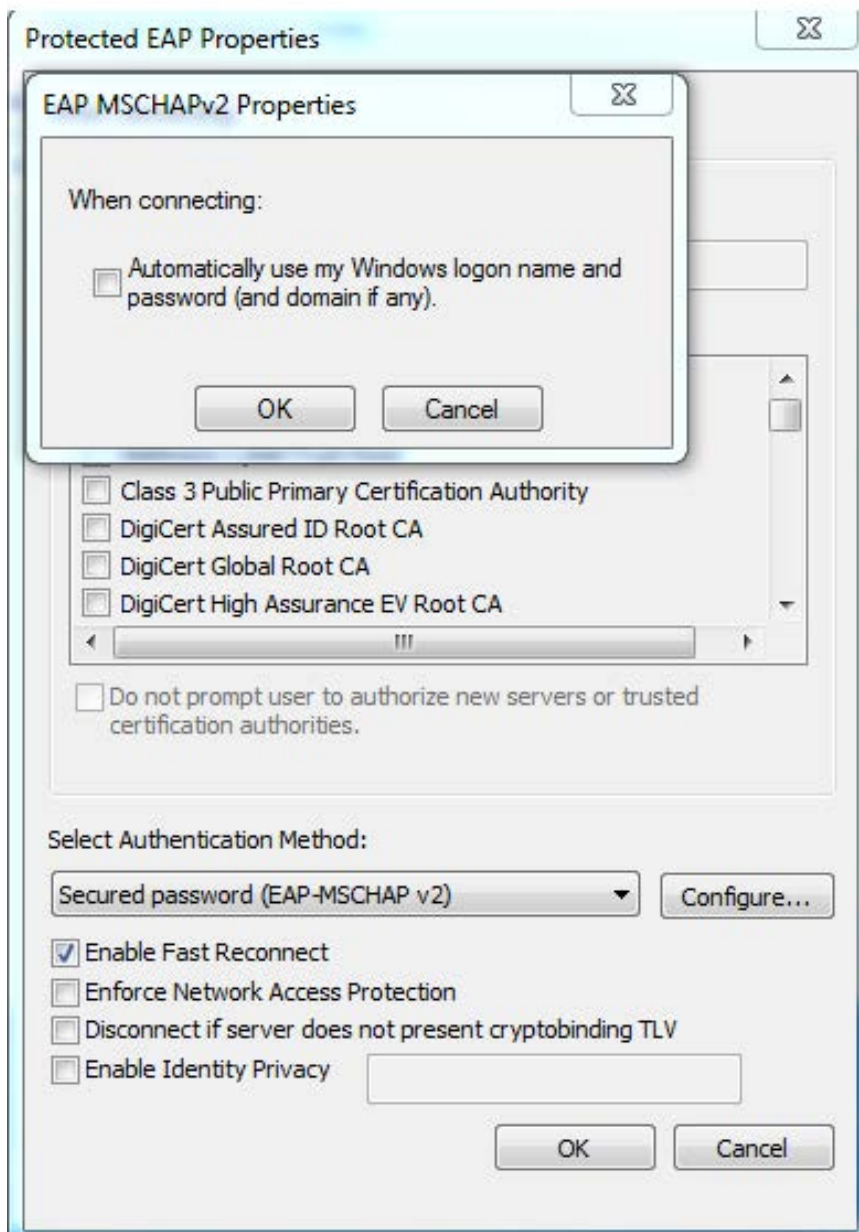


Uncheck Validate server certificate (our certificate is wireless.fairmontstate.edu and is safe to accept)



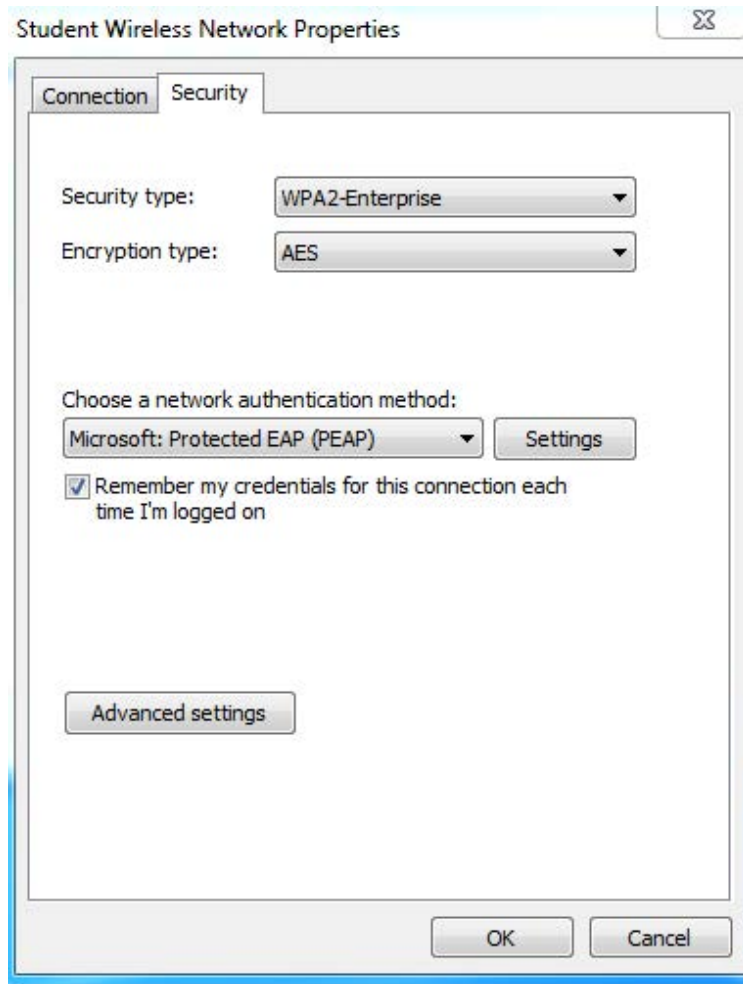
Click Configure... button

Uncheck "Automatically use my Windows logon name and password"

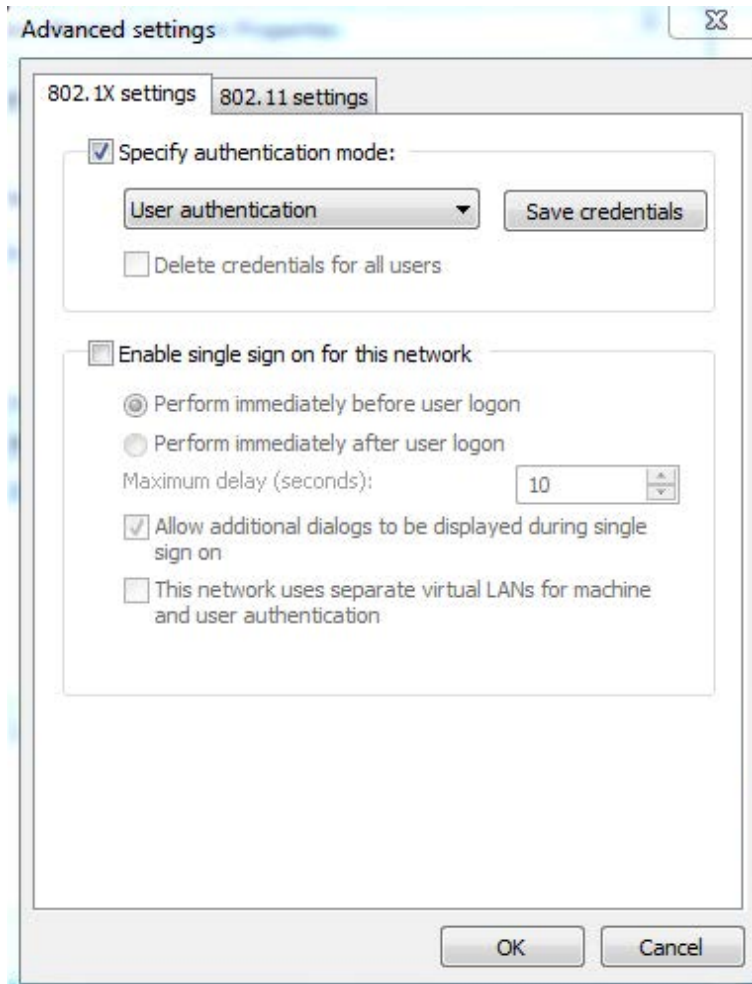


Click OK twice

Click the “Advanced settings”



Check “Specify authentication mode:” and select “User Authentication



Click OK → OK → Close
