

# Campus Carry Implementation Process

1

The Campus Carry Committee (CCC) will consult broadly and offer recommendations on how to implement the law to the President.

2

The President will review the CCC's recommendations, seek additional perspectives, and propose a new policy to the Board of Governors.

3

The Board of Governors will review and approve a new Campus Carry Policy for Fairmont State University.

4

The President will establish any necessary Administrative Procedures and implement the new Board Policy.

## The Campus Carry Committee (CCC)



CCC was established in Fall 2023 to recommend how to comply with the "Campus Self Defense Act"



CCC includes 14 members: students, faculty & staff from across campus



CCC will make recommendations to University Leadership, who will seek additional input



CCC's charge is to ensure a comprehensive & ideologically neutral approach



The law goes into effect on July 1, 2024
